Infants & Young Toddlers
Ages: 6 weeks – 24 months (2 years)

Early Development & Nurturing Foundations

- Sensory exploration and discovery through touch, sound, and movement
- Development of trust, attachment, and emotional security
- Early language exposure through songs, repetition, and interaction
- Gross and fine motor skill development (crawling, walking, grasping)
- Introduction to simple routines and social awareness

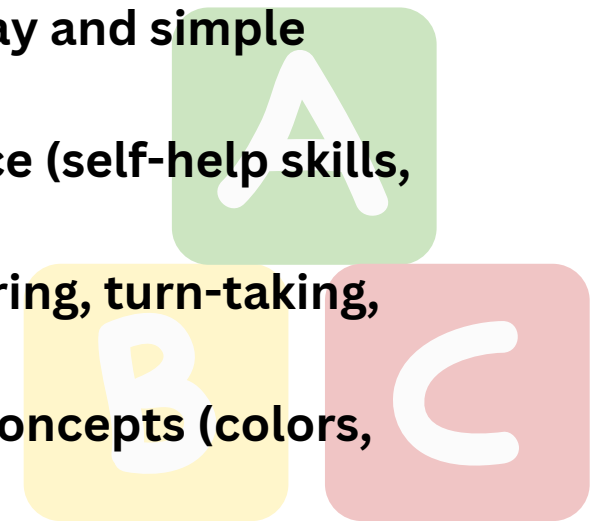


Maple Twos

Early Preschool Ages: 2 – 3 years

Exploration, Language & Independence

- Rapid language development and vocabulary building
- Introduction to structured play and simple learning activities
- Development of independence (self-help skills, routines)
- Social-emotional growth: sharing, turn-taking, expressing needs
- Beginning exposure to early concepts (colors, shapes, numbers, letters)

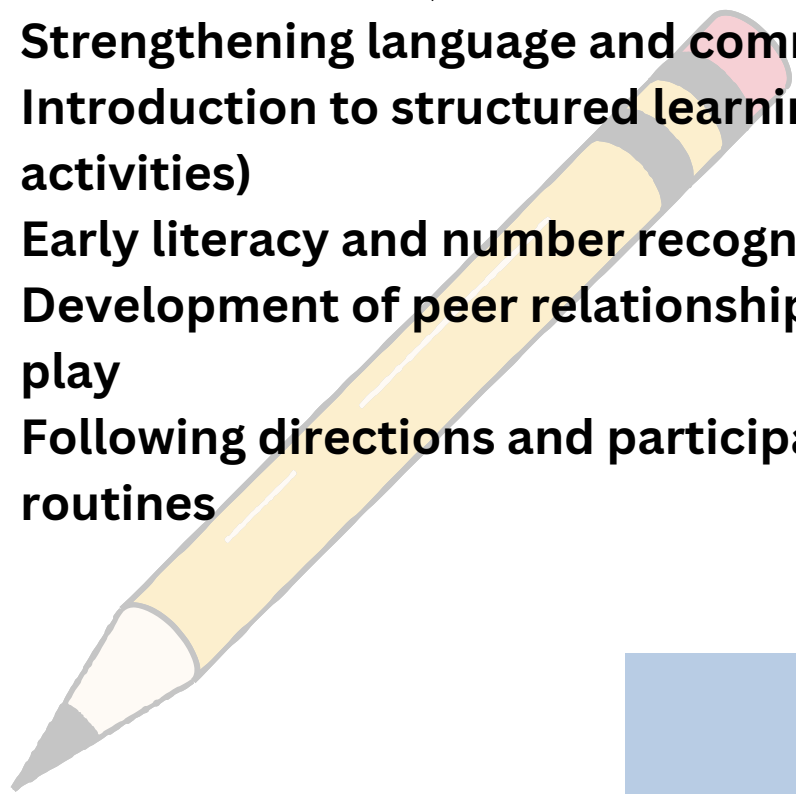


Palm Tree Threes

- Following directions and participating in classroom routines

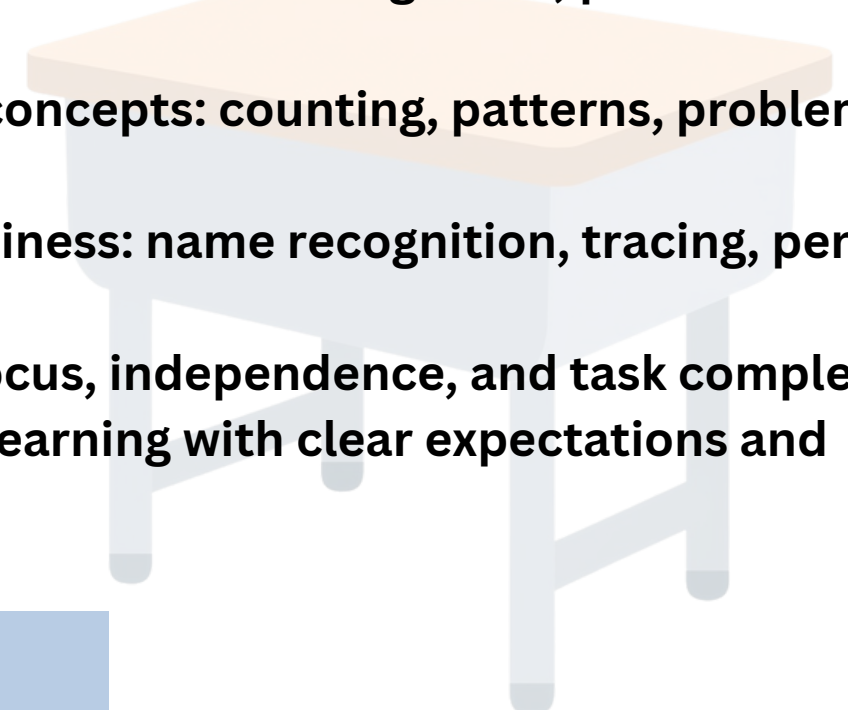


Sycamore Fours

Elementary Readiness & Academic Confidence

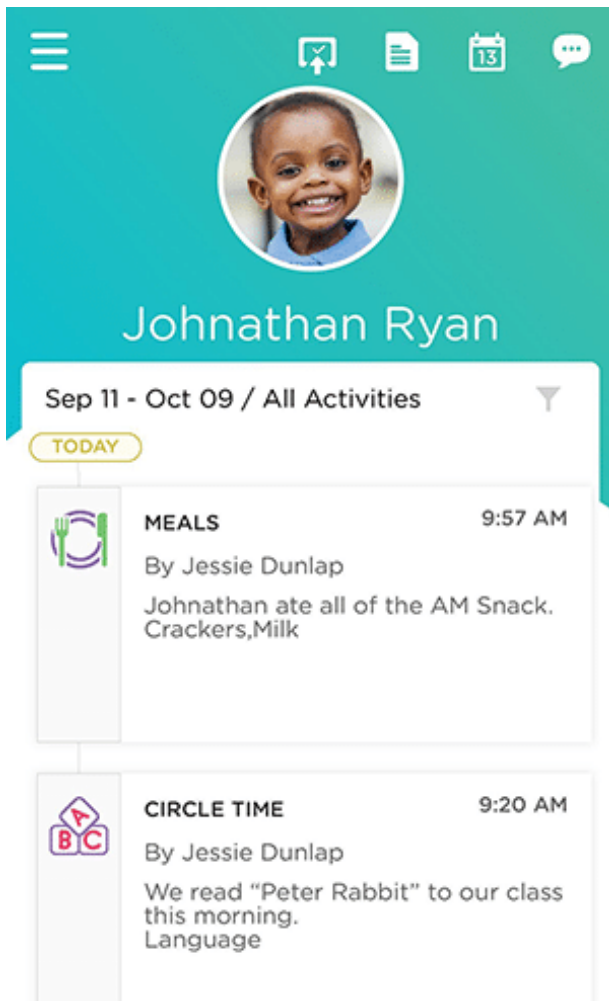
- Strong focus on early reading, writing, and comprehension
